

**SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP  
FALL ROAD INSPECTION  
OCTOBER 20, 2016**

The fall road and ditch inspection meeting was called to order at 8:26 AM at the town hall.  
Board members present: Bill Friedland, Tony Brown, and Steve Lindgren.

Tony drove us through the entire township and generally speaking the roads and ditches were in very good shape.

A few exceptions noted were:

1. 371st Ave. NW had a small pile of firewood stacked in the North ROW.
2. Larch St. NW still has some debris remaining to be removed left over from tree trimming by Shane Olson from SKL Tree Service.
3. 357th between Highway #47 and Blackfoot St. NW has several brush piles in the South ROW needing removal.
4. Dahlia St. NW and 349th t. NW has a wooden post in the ROW needing removal (Dale Smith mailbox area).
5. Jivaro St. NW has about 10 cords of firewood logs placed in the East ROW which presents a hazard and the owner should be notified to remove ASAP.
6. The paved sections of our township were in excellent condition. Crack filling was in excellent shape as well.
7. Driveway permits will be discussed at the monthly meetings.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 12:00 p.m.
