

**SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP
2016 SPRING ROAD INSPECTION
MAY 3, 2016**

Board members present: Steve Lindgren, Bill Friedland, Tony Brown, and Michelle Kleven. Also present was Steve Hass. Brown called the spring road inspection to order at 9:15 a.m. No town residents attended.

The town board discussed filling cracks on blacktop roads. Sealtech Inc. will be repairing all cracks and sweeping this year. Kleven will contact Cambridge Township regarding filling cracks on University Avenue a shared town line road. Keith Hass Construction will be filling the shoulders along blacktop roads with gravel.

The town board discussed dust control. The town board inspected the roadways in the areas the three residents (Pearson-Quapaw, Findell-349th, and Janes-Heather) would like dust control this year. Kleven will contact residents with contact information for scheduling dust control. The township will not be paying for the cost of dust control this year or scheduling, it will be the resident's responsibility.

Street name signs will need to be ordered as follows, 329th Avenue NW and Vale Street NW; 329th Avenue NW and Kerry St NW. Kleven will order 911 address signs for driveway permits at the same time to save on shipping costs and after a sign inventory is completed.

The town board had discussion and review of the current construction on the Lake Elizabeth road improvement project. Kleven will send letters to all the residents to find out if they would be interested in having blacktop extended in their driveways beyond the 2 foot bump outs.

Springvale Township will be contacting Bradford Township to see if they would be interested in snow plowing Vale Street to 329th Avenue intersection in section 35 to prevent snow plows from turning around in residential driveways at the town line.

Lindgren will be doing the 2016 noxious weed report due by June 1, 2016. Central Applicators will be spraying all the brush and weeds in all town road right-of-ways this summer. Kleven will need to put a public notice in the newspaper at 3 weeks prior to spraying. Friedland will work on updating road counts this summer. There are no new culverts to be installed this summer on town roads except in construction zones. The town board discussed two mailbox support replacements in section 36 (Palm & West Briar) along with moving and replacing some mailbox supports in the Lake Elizabeth road improvement project.

There are 6 unapproved expired driveway permits, 4 open driveway permits in progress; and no utility permits open as of May 3, 2016. The town board will request that Koester contact expired permits for status of completion and renewing permit options before contacting Isanti County Zoning or have township complete at the owners cost. Koester to find out status of new lot and road access off of 331st east of lot/permit #54 with no driveway permit. Permit #56 still has black plastic culvert and no work has been done- permit expiring on 6/1/16. Trig Laase needs to be called regarding use of road access off of 329th Avenue (airport road) on south side where chain is and apply for a driveway permit.

The attached map shows where the recommended gravel, road repairs, brushing and tree removal, and road construction for 2016.

Brown adjourned the spring road inspection at 3:30 p.m.


