

**SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP  
2017 SPRING ROAD INSPECTION  
MAY 17, 2017**

Board members present: Steve Lindgren, Bill Friedland, Tony Brown, and Michelle Kleven. Also present was Steve Hass. Lindgren called the spring road inspection to order at 9:00 a.m. No town residents attended. The town board reviewed the 2016 road inspection minutes.

The town board discussed crack filling blacktop roads. All blacktop roads except University Avenue will not need crack filling this year. Lindgren made a motion to see quotes from Cambridge Township regarding the shared town line road before crack filling is done on University Avenue per town line agreement; seconded by Friedland. Motion carried unanimously. Also Cambridge Township is missing a tonnage sign on south end of University.

The town board discussed dust control. The town board inspected the roadways in the areas two residents (Pearson-Quapaw and Findell-349<sup>th</sup>) would like dust control this year. Kleven will contact residents with contact information for scheduling dust control. The township will not be paying for the cost of dust control this year or scheduling, it will be the resident's responsibility.

There were no signs to be ordered, but a few to be installed as follows: All 35MPH speed signs, one hidden driveway, and tonnage signs on the 2016 Lake Elizabeth road improvement; address signs 00049 Dunbar, 00204 353<sup>rd</sup>, and other driveway permit address signs; Remove no parking sign and post on Holly and replace no parking sign on stop ahead post; clear ROW sight lines in Maywood Estates to see signs; install new post for address sign 35025 Lily; the curve sign on Xeon needs to be straightened.

The town board had discussion and review of the current blacktop condition of the Green Meadows development. Friedland made a motion for Kleven to call for chip sealing quotes; seconded by Brown. Motion carried unanimously. The town board also discussed the blacktop caving in due to muskrats on Holly Street. Friedland made a motion to have Sealtech cut out a section of the blacktop, fill, and pack with rock and gravel and repair after a month of packing from driving; seconded by Brown. Motion carried unanimously.

Lindgren will be doing the 2017 noxious weed report. Keith Hass Construction will be spraying all the brush and weeds in all town road right-of-ways this summer. The town board discussed emails received from the county pertaining to noxious weeds. Friedland will work on updating road counts this summer. The town board discussed driveway and utility permits.

Brian Baas sent the town board a request for parking on 329<sup>th</sup> for a wedding this July 28, 2017. The town board discussed. Lindgren made a motion to approve parking on the north side of 329<sup>th</sup> for the Baas event held July 28, 2017 with conditions that any ROW repairs will be at Baas's expense, all neighbors to be notified, and event signage for excess parking be used on East and West end of 329<sup>th</sup>; seconded by Friedland. Motion carried unanimously.

The attached map shows where the recommended gravel, road repairs, brushing and tree removal, and road construction for 2017.

Lindgren adjourned the spring road inspection at 2:00 p.m.

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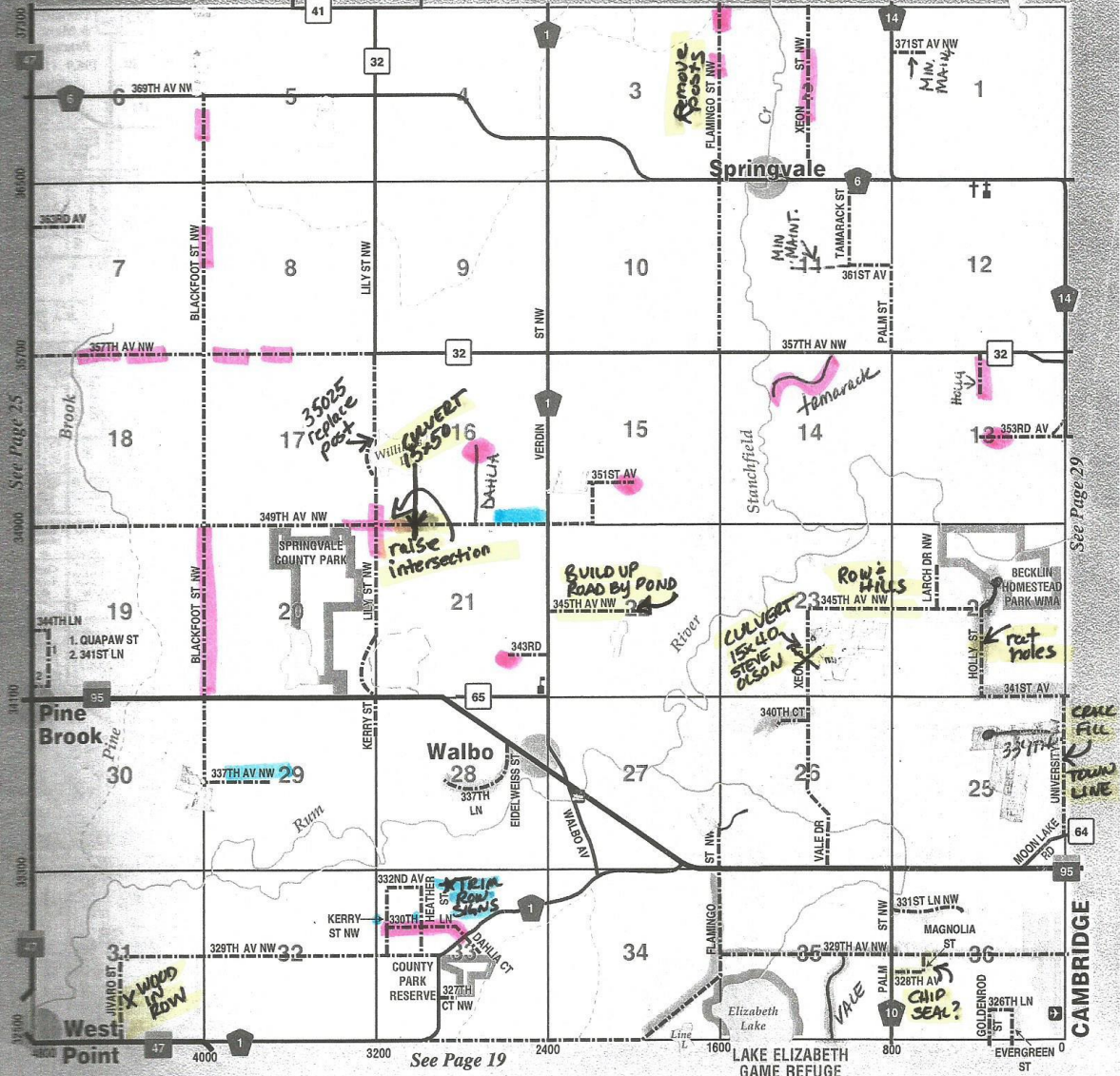
