

**2018 ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES  
SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP  
MARCH 13, 2018**

Michelle Kleven, Town Clerk; called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. 27 residents and 1 non-resident were in attendance. Dennis Valentyn made a motion for Steve Lindgren to be Moderator. Steve Lindgren made a motion for Tony Brown to be Moderator. There was a hand vote. Steve Lindgren received 19 votes and Tony Brown received 2 votes. Bill Friedland seconded the motion to have Steve Lindgren moderator. Motion carried unanimously with one no vote. There were no other moderator nominations. Kleven had copies of the 2017 Annual meeting minutes, 2017 treasurer's reports, 2018 Board of Audit minutes, and agenda's available for all residents. Dennis Valentyn made a motion to approve the 2017 Annual meeting minutes as written. Cory Carlson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Kleven read the 2017 Treasurers report. Bill Friedland made a motion to approve the 2017 Treasurers report as written. Tony Brown seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Neil Olson from Dalbo Fire Department and Cory Carlson from Cambridge Fire Department updated the town residents on the 2017 history of fire calls in Springvale.

There were five 501(C) 3 non-profit organization donation requests. Representatives from four organizations spoke and presented information to the town residents. The town residents had some discussion. Cory Carlson made a motion to donate \$2400.00 total (\$600.00 each) to the four organizations that presented information: Family Pathways, Isanti County Historical Society, Isanti County Safety and Rescue, and Isanti County 4-H. Mike Pintar seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously at 7:03 p.m.

The residents set their 2019 Levies with some discussion. Mike Pintar made a motion to set the general fund at \$65,000.00. Dennis Valentyn seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously at 7:06 p.m. Tim Smith made a motion to set the road and bridge fund at \$150,000.00. Mike Pintar seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously at 7:07 p.m. Cory Carlson made a motion to set the blacktop fund at \$100,000.00. Sherry Monroe seconded the motion. There was some discussion. Cory Carlson made a motion to amend his motion. Sherry Monroe seconded the amended motion. Motion carried with 2 no votes at 7:24 p.m. Cory Carlson made a motion to set the blacktop fund at \$150,000.00. Sherry Monroe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously at 7:26 p.m. Dennis Valentyn made a motion to set the Fire fund at \$40,000.00. Sherry Monroe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously at 7:27 p.m. Glenn Lood made a motion to set the 2019 gopher bounty at \$2.50 per pair of front feet. Dennis Valentyn seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously at 7:30 p.m.

There was some discussion about the township website and township clean-up day scheduled for May 5, 2018. Springvale Township elections will be held on November 6, 2018. Mike Pintar discussed adding stop signs at the intersections of Heather Street and 330<sup>th</sup> and 330<sup>th</sup> and Kerry Street and would like the town board to discuss at their April 4, 2018 meeting. There was some discussion.

Dennis Valentyn made a motion to set the next Annual Town meeting for March 12, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at the Springvale Town hall. Cory Carlson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Cory Carlson made a motion to adjourn the 2018 Annual meeting at 7:40 p.m., seconded by Tony Brown. Motion carried unanimously.
