

**SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP
JUNE 6, 2018
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES**

The township board met at the town hall for its regular monthly meeting with board members present: Tony Brown, Bill Friedland, Michelle Kleven, and Kurt Koester. Steve Lindgren was not present. Friedland called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Brown made a motion to approve the prepared agenda; seconded by Friedland. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Brown made a motion to approve the May monthly minutes and the Spring Road Inspection minutes; seconded by Friedland. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER REPORT: Koester read the Treasurer's reports from May and had no updates on permits. Friedland made a motion to approve the May treasurer reports; seconded by Brown. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Kleven discussed the current claims and payroll, and also updated the board on past due invoices. Friedland made a motion to approve claims #7817 through #7827 for a total of \$33,726.15 and payroll for \$2,232.89; seconded by Brown. Motion carried unanimously. Friedland made a motion to approve gopher bounty claims #953 and #954 in the amount of \$605.00; seconded by Brown. Motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS: Kleven updated the town board on election judge training, upcoming election dates and notices, and new election equipment. Kleven issued the new township membership cards to the town board. No one attended the Cambridge Fire meetings last month.

ROADS: Steve Hass updated the town board on roads. The town board discussed construction areas and installation of new culverts in the township. Kleven will contact the State of Minnesota regarding the email sent regarding the Salt program. Sealtech filled all the cracks in the township roads in May. Allied is scheduled to complete the seal coating projects in June and Kleven delivered notices to residents. The town board discussed the residents requesting magnesium chloride. The town board will start installing signs and complete the weed report in June.

OLD BUSINESS: All old business was tabled to the July meeting.

COMMUNICATION: Kleven discussed postal mail and emails received. Summer Short Courses for the townships are in June, see the MAT website for registration information.
