

SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP
MARCH 7, 2018
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

The township board met at the town hall for its regular monthly meeting with board members present: Steve Lindgren, Tony Brown, Bill Friedland, Michelle Kleven, and Kurt Koester. Friedland called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Lindgren made a motion to approve the prepared agenda; seconded by Brown. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Lindgren made a motion to approve the February monthly minutes; seconded by Brown. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER REPORT: Koester read the Treasurer's reports from February and had no updates on permits. Lindgren made a motion to approve the February treasurer reports; seconded by Brown. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Kleven discussed the current claims and payroll, and also updated the board on past due invoices. Lindgren made a motion to approve claims #7759 through #7772 for a total of \$51,786.52 and payroll for \$1,611.44; seconded by Brown. Motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS: There was some discussion regarding town road maintenance bids/quotes. Friedland made a motion to approve Kleven to publish and post the Town Road Bid and Quote forms to be opened at the April monthly meeting; seconded by Lindgren. Motion carried unanimously.

ROADS: Signs will start to be installed when weather warms up. Steve Hass updated the town board on roads. Kleven updated the town board on the CPV approval. Road weight restrictions will be enforce this month.

OLD BUSINESS: Lindgren updated the town board on the parking lot additional light installation, still waiting for the weather to warm up. Lindgren updated the town board on the Century Link damaged cable invoice from the damage when installing a town road sign and also the process of putting in a claim for the damaged cut town culvert from Century Link. Kleven will send Lindgren the labor and culvert costs for replacing the damaged township culvert by Century Link this month. The town board tabled discussion regarding the fine revenues. The town board had some more discussion regarding a pole barn being built next to the town hall. The town board will wait until the spring thaw to discuss the pole barn and get some measurements. Lindgren updated the town board with information from the Cambridge Fire Meeting.

COMMUNICATION: Kleven discussed postal mail, emails received, and there were no County Zoning minutes pertaining to Springvale. Annual Town Meeting 3/13/18 at 6:30PM; Spring Short Courses in March; Board of Equalization at County Assessor's office 4/17/18 at 7PM; Legal Short Course 4/19/18; County Townships Officers Mtg 4/26/18.

PUBLIC FORUM: Mike and Mich Pintar discussed concerns regarding a possible road improvement in their neighborhood and questions regarding the Town Annual Meeting. They are concerned about the width and line stripping which will increase speed. There was a lengthy discussion.
