

## **Springvale Township**

**October 11, 2021**

### **Fall road inspection.**

Board Members Present: Bill Friedland, Jacob Gillard, Steve Lindgren

Gillard called the meeting to order at 9:15AM.

#### **Work to be done includes:**

1. Culvert markers on 337<sup>th</sup> and the rest of the newly acquired 337<sup>th</sup> west, looks very nice.
2. Lily St. NW needs a culvert replaced due to current one rotting out. Two chevron sign posts need to be installed also. Need a load of gravel @ 34417 driveway & Lily street.
3. Tree needs removal from ditch on Xeon north of Cty. #6. There was also some discussion about removing lilac bushes @ 337<sup>th</sup>/ Blackfoot for Stop sign install and better vision of intersection.
4. The paved roads looked good and we will reassess the need for crack filling next spring during the Spring road inspection. We also discussed the need for road stripping and couldn't affirm a need to do so at this time.
5. Some paved roads will need the corners filled with gravel.
6. The remainder of the roads looked to be in very good condition with normal wear and tear with the exception of the roads affected by the Hwy. 95 road construction unofficial detours which include: 325<sup>th</sup> Ave. NW, Blackfoot St. NW., 349<sup>th</sup> Ave. NW, 345<sup>th</sup> Ave. NW., and 329<sup>th</sup> Ave. NW. The clerk is currently working with the State to get reimbursed for the substantial extra costs incurred to control dust and extra motorgrading of our roads due to the extreme increase of traffic due to said detour.

#### **NOTES:**

Certified letters; requiring their immediate attention and action, need to be sent to the following 2 residents in the township:

1. Pam Mix will have to remove an overhanging tree from 361<sup>st</sup> Court as it is on her property and when the tree falls it will block the street blocking entrance and or exiting for the resident on that street. The tree sits on her property and not in the ROW therefore it is her responsibility to remove ASAP.
2. Also noted, at address 36325 Tamarack St. NW. is an illegal mailbox support. The support consists of old tires and wheels and an old freezer or refridgerator. This resident has been notified by a note in the mailbox a month ago to either replace with a compliant support or notify a supervisor to have it replaced and resident has not yet complied. This will have to be done within 7 days or the township will install a new mailbox support and bill the resident for such work and material. The current support had been spray painted with orange marking paint so we will know to whom the tires/wheels and freezer belongs to in the event it finds it's way into a township ditch elsewhere. The resident has since spray painted over the orange spraypaint with black paint. This resident should also be advised that the current support needs to be removed from the ROW at the time the new mailbox support is installed, within the next 7 days.

**More notes:** do we have 911 signs for 33924 and 33946 residents?
