

**SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP POLICY 100-06
CULVERT PURCHASE WITH DRIVEWAY PERMIT**

When a driveway permit application has been requested and the inspection by a town board member of the location has been completed, it is then determined if a culvert will be needed.

Before a new culvert (per specifications on driveway permit) is ordered, the new culvert with aprons must be paid for, in full, by the applicant including any extra parts and or sales tax. A town board member will call the Isanti County Highway Department and find out the cost of the new culvert, if the culvert is available in inventory, and notify the applicant.


After receipt of payment (cash, money order, or cashiers check) in full by the applicant is made to Springvale Township for the new culvert and the applicant notifies a town board member of when the culvert is needed, a town board member will order the new culvert giving the Isanti County Highway Department at least 24 hours notice (for in stock culverts) for the applicant to pick up their new culvert.
