**RESOLUTION TO ERECT REGULATORY SPEED SIGNS IN URBAN  
RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, Minn. Stat. § 169.14, subd. 2(a) establishes a 35 M.P.H. speed limit on town roads in urban residential districts;

**WHEREAS**, an “urban residential district” is defined in Minn. Stat. § 169.011, subd. 90, as “the territory contiguous to and including any ... town road that is built up with... dwelling houses situated at intervals averaging less than 100 feet for a distance of a quarter mile or more.”

**WHEREAS**, the town board has determined, as a result of on-site inspections, the following road(s) or road segment(s) are within an urban residential district as defined above:

The bituminous service sections of Eidelweiss Street and 337<sup>th</sup> Lane in section 28.

**WHEREAS**, as a town road(s) within a urban residential district the legislature has established the speed limit to be 35 m.p.h. without the need for a speed study by the Minnesota Department of Transportation;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the town board of Springvale Township, Isanti County, Minnesota that 35 M.P.H. regulatory speed limit signs be erected on the above described road(s) or road segment(s) in accordance with the Minnesota Uniform Manual on Traffic Control Devices.
