**RESOLUTION OF TOWNSHIP BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 2021.3**

**RESOLUTION TO REMOVE "MINIMUM-MAINTENANCE ROAD"
DESIGNATION FROM 361st Avenue NW now named 361st Court NW in section 11
(the "Road" as herein more specifically defined).**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Springvale Township hereby resolves as follows:

The Town Board determined that State law and public safety interests require the Town to remove the minimum-maintenance designation from the Road;

FINDINGS

The Town Board of Springvale Township hereby finds:

That entire portion of 361st Court NW road is designated as a "minimum-maintenance road" under Minnesota Statutes, section 160.095 because passenger and commercial use along the road was occasional or intermittent;

- The minimum-maintenance designation begins at Tamarack Street, the NW corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 11, Township 36, Range 24, Isanti County, Minnesota proceeding west along north line of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section to center of section 11 and there terminating. This roadway is 66 feet (four rods) in width and length of 1,320 feet more or less (the "Road").
- Signs posted along this stretch of road indicate that it is minimally maintained and warn motorists to travel at their own risk.

The "minimum maintenance" designation is no longer appropriate because a resident has moved onto a property located on or along the Road; use of the Road is, or will become, more than just occasional or intermittent; therefore, the Road's designation as minimally maintained is no longer appropriate under section 160.095 and such a designation would pose a threat to public safety;

It is the intention of the Town that its roads are safe for commercial and passenger vehicle travel and compliant with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations;

The purpose of this change is public safety and legal compliance; and

Therefore, the Town Board of Springvale Township resolves to remove the "minimum-maintenance road" designation for the above-referenced Road and increase maintenance accordingly.


RESOLUTION

The Town Clerk is forthwith directed to notify the local residents and land owners of the Town's removal of the minimum-maintenance designation from the Road.
